Stadium model to go on tour

A scale model of the proposed Dunedin stadium was unveiled to media yesterday and is expected to go on tour around the southern region.

The 1-to-300 scale model includes all the features of the third of four design stages.

Stadium development director Darren Burden said the model would give a sense of the space and volume of the facility.

"Once people see the model in three dimensions they get a clear sense of just how good it will be." The model shows the stadium set up to its maximum 30,500 seats. The various parts can be dismantled so that the components can be viewed more easily.

While it was planned that the model would tour the region south of the Waitaki, dates and locations of when the public could view the model had not been confirmed, a spokesman said.
